### ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR APPLICANTS FROM VISA COUNTRIES

Are you from a country with visa requirements to enter the Czech Republic? Yes

We are grateful that you feel dedicated to come to the Czech Republic even with the obstacle that obtaining a visa presents. The visa process takes a lot of time and money from our side because we must provide you with important documents and get them to you, which usually costs us around 150 € per participant. We would like to avoid the situation where the candidate changes their mind at the last minute. That is why we charge a refundable administrative fee of 50 €. The fee will be required from you after your acceptance of a placement and before we start the visa process. After your arrival in the Czech Republic and after you start your voluntary service, the fee will be refunded back to you. In case you withdraw from the placement offer after we start the visa process, the fee will not be refunded back to you. In case you cannot afford to pay the fee, contact one of our coordinators directly.

I understand that my application will not be returned to me in case of a rejection or withdrawal, but will be destroyed securely. I have completed the application myself. I agree that my personal information in this application may be used for statistic and internal purposes of Slezská diakonie (InterVIA program), based on the right, under GDPR, to access personal data, for the application process as well as the process of finding and selection of a placement. It may also be passed on to key persons in the host organizations and placements. InterVIA, the hosting organizations and placements declare that all data will be treated according to the GDPR and the local laws regarding the processing of personal data. In cases where an application is withdrawn or rejected, Slezská diakonie will automatically delete all personal data.
